

UNIFORMS/DRESS CODE

The purpose of our dress code is to set a common standard of modesty, neatness and appropriateness, as well as encourage a level of excellence for all students. Please note some items have been added to the acceptable daily uniform policy for the 2020-2021 school year in order to accommodate more outdoor learning and physical activity.

Uniform Ordering Information:

All items worn on the top half of the body (including polo shirts, dresses, fleece, sweaters, etc.) must have a HOPE logo. These items should be ordered through HOPE's dedicated Land's End site <https://hopek12.com/admissions/uniforms-spiritwear/> or our Logo Spiritwear provider: <https://hopeacademy.orderpromos.com/> Uniforms should be replaced when they are too short, small, dingy, excessively faded or when holes or large stains are visible.

Annual Theme T-Shirts

Each student is required to purchase a current year HOPE Theme T-Shirt. These shirts feature our theme and Bible verse for the corresponding year. Theme T-Shirts are worn on the 1st Tuesday of each month, Spirit Days, and any other days as communicated by HOPE. Theme T -Shirts may be worn with jeans with no rips or tears or athletic shorts/pants that are below fingertip length and bottoms that are loose fitting.

The items in this section may be purchased from any vendor.

Pants, shorts, capris, skirts and skorts:

Items should be loose-fitting, but not excessively baggy. Skirts and shorts should be fingertip length or longer.

Approved colors: Khaki and Navy.

Athletic pants and shorts:

Items should be loose-fitting, but not excessively baggy and fingertip length or longer. Leggings/ form-fitting items are not permitted.

Approved colors include: Khaki, Gray, or Navy, (solid color preferred.)

Socks:

Socks should be one solid color, no logos/designs.

Approved colors include: Navy, White, Gray, Black

Shoes:

Tennis shoes are strongly advised for all grades. Students will be outside and active everyday.

Flip flops and sandals and heels greater than 1" are not permitted.

Modesty shorts, tights or leggings should be worn under dresses and skirts. These items should be plain (no printed patterns).

Approved colors: Navy and White

Outerwear:

Any outerwear, coats and jackets, worn inside the classroom must have a HOPE logo. Outerwear worn for outside activity only does not have to have a logo.

Undershirts:

Only white undershirts may be worn and should be tucked in.

Jewelry:

Only girls may have pierced ears and no more than two per earlobe; no other body piercing is permitted.

Hair:

Should be tidy and not distract from learning or the ability to make eye contact.

Face Coverings:

Color and design of choice.

Non-Uniform days: There will be days when students are permitted to wear the clothing of their choice that follows dress code policies. Please be mindful that all clothing and face coverings worn on campus or at school events should include only images and messages that are uplifting and align with the values of HOPE Academy. Clothing of any kind, when worn at school, should be free from communicating social and political viewpoints.
